

Do Panels Move? Yes, typically not much, but they do move with the changes in air temperature.

The expansion or contraction of a 100' Long metal panel during a 100° change in temperature will be about 3/4". With a "thru fastener" panel or "exposed fastener" panel, that movement will likely be taken up in what is referred to as "Thermal Bow". Since most panels are less than 40' in length, you are not likely to be experiencing any more than 1/8" to 1/4" panel movement during a 100° temperature swing.
